Lighting your Uuni 3

				
<p>Step 1</p> <p>Insert the hopper screw halfway as shown above.</p>	<p>Step 2</p> <p>Insert the pellet slide. There should be a gap of around 3cm between the end of the pellet slide and the wall of the hopper.</p>	<p>Step 3</p> <p>Place a fire lighter at the front of the burner tray.</p>	<p>Step 4</p> <p>Arrange approximately one scoop around the fire lighter with pellets.</p>	<p>Step 5</p> <p>Your burner tray should look like this. Remember not to overfill the tray.</p>
				
<p>Step 6</p> <p>Light the firelighter and slide the tray into the burner.</p>	<p>Alternative Step 6</p> <p>Skip step 3 and use the hole on the side of the burner to light the pellets with a blowtorch.</p>	<p>Step 7</p> <p>As the pellets start to catch fire add in more pellets.</p>	<p>Step 8</p> <p>Fill the hopper to around this point.</p>	<p>Step 9</p> <p>Remember to keep the pellets topped up whilst cooking.</p>

Extinguishing your Uuni 3

		
<p>Step 1 To extinguish the pellets pull out the tray using the handle. We advise wearing a heatproof glove when moving the tray.</p>	<p>Step 2 The embers will still be HOT so be careful removing the tray.</p>	<p>Step 3 Carefully shake the burned pellets into the water but don't drop the whole tray in.</p>

A couple further notes:

1. Wind can effect the performance of your Uuni. If possible, find a spot sheltered from wind or point the back of the Uuni upwind. Don't use in high winds.
2. As with any wood-fired or BBQ product exercise caution when using Uuni, whilst kids love pizza only adults should use Uuni.
